No Office from Jail: The Amendment That Could Change India

It's time to move away from Two Indias: a government employee gets suspended in 48 hours, but a politician can continue to hold office from jail indefinitely. No restrictions. How long will we tolerate a system that rewards impunity for the powerful and punishes the powerless? In what stands as, perhaps, India's biggest strike on corruption, and the criminalization of politics in the 21st century, the Modi government has introduced the "The Constitution (One Hundred and Thirtieth Amendment) Bill".

This bill draws a big red line against tainted politicians holding offices indefinitely despite serious criminal charges. Provisions of the said bill are enough to hold individuals accused of wrongdoing who continue to operate under the guise of public service across the country.

Interestingly, PM Narendra Modi has not just ensured that his own post falls within the

ambit of this double-edged sword but has also reignited his old saying- "Na Khaunga, Na Khane Dunga" (I won't be corrupt, nor will I permit it under my watch).

Amid protests and sloganeering courtesy TMC MP Kalyan Banerjee, Union home minister Amit Shah introduced the bill on August 20.

Provisions of the bill read... Prime minister of the country, Chief minister, or a minister of any state government/UT, if arrested or detained for 30 consecutive days in a case punishable up to 5 years of imprisonment or more, shall be relieved from duties by the 31st day. If the Prime minister does not advise the President by this time, the Minister shall be removed automatically. Same applies for the states, with the Governor acting on advice of the Chief minister.

Opposition is raising questions about the government's intentions, but the legislation is the need of the hour. Justice in our country is often delayed to an extent that the damage is already done, and the verdict

hardly compensates for the harm endured. Our justice system has become a playground for the powerful, while the common man waits in despair. Corruption allegations are made, trials run indefinitely, charge sheets are piled up, powerful figures manipulate complainants, lower court decisions are challenged in the high courts, and the matter loses relevancy by the time apex court is approached for an ultimate settlement.

This loophole has been long exploited by politicians who treat state's exchequer as their personal reserve, granting funds to loyalists, ensuring luxuries for their families, educating their children abroad, & in expanding the empire, with citizens being the ultimate sufferers.

How much more? Our country is deep-rooted in corruption, and sadly, people are now desensitized with it. They no longer find it surprising because it doesn't happen anymore in the dark, and bribery is as common as traffic in Delhi.

A government employee is

deemed to have been suspended if he is kept in custody for more than 48 hours. No formal order is required. But a politician is 'elite' and enjoys a free run! This glaring double standard exposes the rot eating away at India's democracy. Perhaps the constitutional assembly didn't realize that the country would face such figures who would not relinquish the Chief minister's post even in custody.

Union home minister Amit Shah has publicly accepted that had Kejriwal resigned after being jailed in the Delhi Liquor policy scam, the need for this legislation wouldn't have arisen. Delhi High court had also highlighted the absence of a law that bars leaders from running the government from jail, when a PIL was filed during Kejriwal's case. Similar case was seen in Tamil Nadu when a minister jailed for corruption was retained in the cabinet by CMMK Stalin for months. Let us be firm. Public service is not a right, but a responsibility. Public deserves a clean slate, not tainted charge sheets. The Su-

preme Court, in the Lilly Thomas judgment advocated for the same, although the Manmohan Singh government tried its level best to stop disqualification of members convicted for 2, or more years.

But the opposition remains overly suspicious of the government's intentions. They fear the government would use this as a tool to crumble down governments in opposition ruled states, citing examples of Delhi, and Jharkhand. Yet, the fact that the bill has been sent to a Select Committee speaks otherwise, if the government's motive was indeed to bulldoze through with hidden agendas, why open it to scrutiny and detailed examination? Although some of these could be just, many of the critics themselves carry political baggage, which suggests otherwise. Apex Congress family is charge-sheeted in the National Herald Scam, RJD's Lalu Prasad is a convicted corrupt in the 'Fodder Scam', Tejaswi has been named in the 'Land for Job' scam. TMC has a well packed lineup of corruption charged leaders,

multiple ministers have served a jail term with piles of cash recovered, Kejriwal and corruption is frequently mentioned in the same breath, and others too face multiple cases. Cases alone don't guarantee a scam, but the public posturing often does.

When the net of the law tightens, the shark screams 'vendetta witch-hunt', as if the accountability is only for the small fishes (government employees).

What drives PM Narendra Modi apart is his conviction against corruption. Eleven years in office, not a single corruption charge on him, or any of his ministers. In a political landscape riddled with scandals, that spotless record shines like a beacon of hope.

This sets him apart. Steering a country where scam exclusives had become a daily affair, Modi's clean slate makes his word feel less like a slogan, and more like a standard. Shah tweeted that the initial draft didn't consider the Prime minister's position to be falling under this law, but PM Nar-

endra Modi directed that the Prime Minister be included as well. Knowing that this could go against his own party if misused by any future government, he dares to take bold steps, something that has become his trademark in the last 11 years.

This law doesn't prevent any leader from getting reinstated to the position on the release from custody. The very inclusion of this clause shatters the narrative that this is a political vendetta, it is a fight for integrity. Anyone who is automatically sacked on Day 31 for non-compliance can always get back to his post, once free. This further weakens the narrative that this is being brought with dishonest motives, had it been the case, nothing forced the Modi-Shah duo to include this clause. They could've simply called it redundant, citing the fall of moral competency to hold any position on the day of arrest itself. But will the government manage to pass this legislation? Being a constitutional amendment, this requires a 2/3rd majority in

each House. NDA stands short of even 300, and thus the magic number of about 362 (if all members are present) is an uphill task.

No opposition party seems to favour it currently. All are hell bent on calling it an evil act to crush the opposition at the federal level, raising flags over its intentions.

Come what may. This move would go down in the history books as one of the finest acts ever to crush criminalization of politics. BJP too has a spree of leaders at the state level with criminal allegations, but this is what makes Narendra Modi apart, even in his own party. This is not just legislation, it's a declaration that corruption, no matter how high, will no longer be untouchable. The nation must watch, and keep a note of those who vote against this legislation. Anyone standing in the way of a cleaner public life must be judged not by their slogans, but by their votes.

Demographic changes a deliberate design: Shah

Union Home Minister Amit Shah, on Tuesday, stated that demographic changes in border areas are not happening randomly but are part of a deliberate design that threatens national security.

During a workshop for the Vibrant Villages Programme (VVP), he urged district collectors and chief secretaries to take this issue seriously, echoing a concern previously raised by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

Shah specifically instructed district collectors to remove all illegal religious encroachments within a 30-kilometer radius of the borders, citing them as a key part of this "deliberate design." He praised Gujarat's administration for its successful efforts in clearing such encroachments along its maritime and land borders.

The Home Minister also highlighted the need for a new administrative approach in the VVP, stressing the importance of preventing residents from migrating away from border villages. He emphasised three

'NEPO'LITICS IN BIHAR?

As Bihar gears up for its next Assembly elections, a new wave of political hopefuls is emerging from prominent political families. Though the entry of Chief Minister Nitish Kumar's son, Nishant Kumar, remains uncertain, many other leaders are actively working to launch their children's careers.

Several names are already making headlines, including Osama Shahab 'son of the late RJD MP Mohammad Shahabuddin, and Arijit Shashwat, son of former Union Minister Ashwini Choubey. Other contenders include Anshuman, son of former MP Anand Mohan, and Sarthak Ranjan, son of Independent MP Pappu Yadav. Ab-

himanyu, the son of BJP leader Ram Kripal Yadav, is also expected to enter the race.

These hopefuls represent a cross-section of Bihar's political landscape, with lobbying efforts coming from parties like the RJD, BJP, and JD(U). Sources suggest that as many as 16 political families are preparing to field their children. This trend of dynastic politics is not new to Bihar, where figures like Tejashwi Yadav, Misa Bharati, and Shambhavi Choudhary have already established their political presence. The upcoming elections are set to continue this pattern, as the next generation vies for a place in the state's legislature.

PRIYANKA JOINS RAGA'S YATRA



In a significant show of unity for the INDIA bloc, senior Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi Vadra joined her brother, Rahul Gandhi, in Bihar for his "Voter Adhikar Yatra."

Respect chairs in state: Didi to PM

Days after Prime Minister Narendra Modi called TMC "thieves", West Bengal CM Mamata Banerjee on Tuesday slammed the PM saying that he should "respect chairs in the state".

"Since I respect the chair of Prime Minister... similarly, he should also respect the chair(s) in state. They (BJP) are calling us thieves but the biggest thieves are in Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh and in Bihar. BJP holds meetings with the thieves there. A total of 186 central teams were sent to Bengal and we have replied to all their queries... but even then, they aren't clearing funds for different schemes," said Mamata.

Mamata also alleged that the Prime Minister visits the state like a 'migratory' bird ahead of every election.

Bihar cabinet okays Industrial Promotion Package

Bihar cabinet on Tuesday gave its nod to the "Bihar Industrial Investment Promotion Package 2025" with an objective to attract industrial investment, particularly large private investments, in the state.

The approval was given in the cabinet meeting, chaired by chief minister Nitish Kumar.

The package includes provisions such as free land, financial incentives and other related concessions to create a conducive atmosphere for the state's "rapid industrial development".

The decision regarding the promotion package is in line with the announcements

made by CM to grant concessions to industries, and also with the government's commitment to create one crore employment opportunities in the state over the next five years. Bihar chief secretary Amrit Lal Meena said in a post-meeting media briefing, "If an investor makes an investment of Rs 100 crore and creates 1,000 direct employment opportunities, the investor will get 10 acres of land from the government free of cost. Those willing to invest Rs 1,000 crore will get 25 acres of land depending on the project, whereas if a Fortune 500 company invests in the state, it will get 10 acres of land," Meena said, while exuding confidence that the move will attract big-ticket investments to the state.

RSS ANTHEM: DKS apologises to Bloc partners

After reciting the RSS anthem at the Assembly snowballed into a controversy, Karnataka Deputy Chief Minister DK Shivakumar has apologised to the Bloc partners at the Centre and party workers saying... "If he had hurt their feelings"...

The issue was also discussed among Bloc partners at national level, where some expressed doubts if DK Shivakumar was soft peddling with Hindutva.

Without looking into the issue completely, they have just cut and pasted the anthem recital part and made it a political issue," Shivakumar said.

An unusual case from Rampur district has drawn wide attention after a young married woman proposed in front of a panchayat that she would divide her time equally between her husband and her lover. The woman suggested spending 15 days every month with her husband and 15 days with her lover.

The incident took place in the Azimnagar police station area of Rampur. According to local accounts, the woman was married about a year and a half ago to a youth from a nearby village. Since her marriage, she had allegedly eloped with her lover nearly ten times.

Troubled by the repeated episodes, the family and villagers called a panchayat in the hope of resolving the matter.

What followed surprised everyone. When asked to choose between her husband and her lover, the woman said she would not leave either.

Instead, she declared that she would adopt what she

called the "Bhutan model," under which she would live 15 days with her husband and 15 days with her lover every

month. The proposal shocked the gathering and was immediately rejected by the panchayat.
